1. **Ethical Review**: To review and approve research proposals involving human subjects, ensuring ethical compliance and participant safety.



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- 2. **Informed Consent**: To verify that informed consent is obtained properly, clearly, and voluntarily from all participants.
- 3. **Participant Protection**: To safeguard the rights, dignity, privacy, and welfare of research participants, especially vulnerable groups.
- 4. **Monitoring and Oversight**: To monitor approved research periodically, including progress reports, adverse events, and deviations.
- 5. **Protocol Amendments**: To evaluate and approve any changes to the research protocol post-approval.
- 6. **Complaint Handling**: To receive and address ethical concerns or complaints related to ongoing research.
- 7. **Documentation**: To maintain proper records of all IEC activities, including proposals reviewed, minutes of meetings, and communications.
- 8. Compliance: To ensure adherence to ICMR, GCP, Schedule Y, and AYUSH-specific ethical norms.
